**1. MINUTES OF THE OCTOBER 24<sup>TH</sup> BOARD MEETING:** The minutes were approved as submitted.

#### 3. TREASURER'S REPORT

- Approved the October financial statement
  - o Total: \$115,379.49
    - Yearly Operating Budget: \$46,865.74
    - Checking Balance: \$68,513.75
- Update on transferring assets to the Cities of Boulder Chief Calderazzo: hold until next month's meeting
- Update on COB invoice per BCRFTC Lease Agreement: runs January to December; will be billed in April for the current year. Completed.
- Proposed 2018 budget: hold the motion to approve until next month's meeting
  - Board looking to start supplying coffee for user members: proposed budget line for \$2000 or possibly COB billing the board for a portion of the overall bill at the end of year
  - Add line for purchase of propane: \$2000
  - Add maintenance budget line: \$3000
  - Add Facility Rental Income: \$12,600
  - Add internet hosting fee for website and Calcium calendar upkeep: \$500
  - Raise budget line for transportation fees (\$400 per trip vs \$350) to adjust for contractor's fees
  - Add in transportation repairs for new tires on trailers
  - o Proposed that any remainder flows into section 4005, facility maintenance

## 4. BOULDER FACILITY REPORT

- Chief Mygatt discussed token of appreciation for former board member, Linton.
  - ACTION NEEDED: Cmdr. Enholm will run point and report options at next month's board meeting.

## Chief Ginsberg

- Updated board on compressor system back in full operation
  - Can only fill to 4500psi as the system has been reset to manufacturer specs.

- To upgrade the compressor system to 5500 will be between \$12-15k, but the City of Boulder will not be upgrading their SCBA until maybe 2019.
- It was decided to limit the cascade system to fill bottles to 4500psi.
- Updated board on weight room and members utilizing center outside of sponsored department trainings / academy sessions
  - Due to safety and liability concerns, members can only utilize the weight room during normal work hours: M-F 8am-5pm. The weight room may be scheduled outside those times by member agencies as part of a structured training program.
  - ACTION NEEDED: Chief Ginsberg will take a full inventory of the weight room so the board may decide what they will be responsible for maintaining and/or replacing.

# Capt. Koch

- Updated board on new website and Calcium calendar transfer.
  - Will be approx. \$30/mo to host Calcium on bcrftc.org site
  - Budget line item to be added onto 2018's proposed budget
- Next Facility Orientation Session on Dec. 2<sup>nd</sup>
  - 9 people signed up so far
  - Additional orientation on Jan. 18<sup>th</sup> scheduled. May add a possible February date if needed.
  - BCRFTC User Member Agreements need to be revised to include the Facility Orientation requirement
  - ACTION NEEDED: Capt. Koch will work with Chief Snyder to revise the user member agreements for next year.
