- Discussed notification to COB's Public Works regarding water use for live burns.
  Board recommended extending this notification to cover all water flow activities at the FTC including aerial/pump testing and hose training.
- Action Needed: Find out how PW would like to be notified regarding water use BFR's DC Durre will coordinate with PW. Capt. Koch will work on the technology piece.
- Chief Snyder
  - Updated board on user member agreements for 2018 *Distributed to agencies, and invoices have been sent out.*
- Chief Ginsberg
  - Updated board on card reader access at main reservoir gate BFR and P&R had a productive meeting regarding pin pad system. Further research is being done to determine cost and will include the pin pad access to the door.

    - Diagonal Gate: Possible remote access tbd
  - Updated board on propane prop delivery system with quotes *Delivery system installed above ground. Propane tank has been moved within the containment*

system. Amerigas was the lead on this project. Plumbed in rigid line, above ground, tacked into the ground. All safety systems are still place.

  - Install metering system Amerigas is researching what they can provide for that system.
- Hydrant on the island is OOS due to cracked barrel under concrete. Work order has been submitted to COB Water Works.
