 MINUTES FROM MAY 22, 2018 BOARD MEETING: The minutes were approved as submitted.

2. TREASURER'S REPORT

- Approved May's financial statement.
 - o Total: \$134,503.03
 - Yearly Operating Budget: \$65,982.57
 - Checking: \$68,520.46
- Updated on transferring assets to the City of Boulder.
 - Tabled to next meeting
 - Chief Snyder will send out asset list to board.

3. BOULDER FACILITY REPORT

- Capt. Koch to updated Board on:
 - Calcium calendar notification system for any reservation on the burn building and pump pit
 - Still progress
 - Placing Longmont burn building floor plans on BCRFTC Board website
 - Floor plans have been submitted. Chief Dirr will add in gpm, and Capt.
 Koch has added it to the website.
- Chief Dirr and Capt. Koch to updated board on gear dryer for FTC
 - To be tabled to next month
- Chief Ginsberg to updated board on burn building repairs.
 - Scheduled for first and second week of July. Reservation calendar has been blocked off for this time.
 - Next coring test for burn building will be in 2020.
- Michelle to discussed payment options of outstanding 2016 invoice from Stanley Security.
 - To be paid by board.
- Landscaping has been done, and Chief Ginsberg will research options for a long-term contract.

4. LONGMONT FACILITY REPORT

 Quick jam doors on tower are torn up due to being pried on. These will be replaced, but the type of door is still tbd.

5. LIVE BURN TRAILERS

- The gray trailer is at Lafayette.
- The green trailer is at Boulder Training Center.

6. OTHER BUSINESS TO DISCUSS

- SWAT obstacle course Discussion needed about possible usage and reservation.
 - o ACTION NEEDED: Chief Ginsberg will contact BPD.
- Confined space prop Prefer to keep this prop under Boulder Fire-Rescue; potential to open prop up to user agencies. Would then add in blueprint for prop on the BCRFTC website should it be opened to other agencies.
- Alternative smoke options for training smoke: smoke candles, cold smoke generator (class A), theatrical smoke
 - More research needed for smoke candles re: CO production; cold smoke generator not recommended; theatrical smoke is still preferred.
 - Water-based fluids for theatrical smoke can cause a vapor issue during colder months which creates an icy, slick surface on walking surfaces.
 - o Smoke candle would potentially still create an IDLH environment due to irritants.
 - Board approves additional research into viable smoke options.
- Compressor upgrades at Boulder FTC: The City of Boulder will be upgrading the compressor to include a 4-bank cascade and a separate, 4-bottle external fill station; will have regulator preset for 5500; approximately \$12k for work.
 - City of Boulder has established an internal air compressor team to perform maintenance in addition to quarterly and annual air quality testing.
